# ST ALLEN PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 21st MARCH 2022 AT ST ALLEN CHURCH

## 1. Appointment of Chairman:

1.1 The Clerk advised that due to illness several Councillors were absent. However, the Council was quorate so the meeting could continue.

#### RESOLVED: JO elected as Acting Chairman.

Due to the fact that there were several important items on the agenda that should be discussed by the Full Council it was **RESOLVED to organise an Extra-Ordinary Parish Council Meeting on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March at <b>7.30pm in St. Allen Church**. Each Agenda item was discussed and it was decided to either defer them to next week's meeting or the April meeting of the Full Council.

## 2. Suggestions from Members of the Public:

2.1 The Local Residents in attendance were all present to discuss issues relating to the A30 dualling.

One Resident advised that the Bridleway from Hill House to Tolgroggan is now unusable and Harris Fencing has been erected by Hill House to prevent use. It was commented that a new bridleway should have been created before this one was closed.

The owner of Tolcarne Farm said that the lanes around their farm are frequently becoming gridlocked due to vehicles diverting off the A30 when there is heaving traffic. They are often unable to leave their property which is unacceptable. It was requested that signage be installed on the A30 advising vehicles to remain on the A30.

PM commented that lots of people have complained about the effect of the roadworks but no action is being taken.

It was reported that a Costain vehicle had gone into the fence by Engelly. When will this be repaired?

An incident today hi-lighted the fact that emergency vehicles are unable to access the lanes around Trerice and this also needs to be addressed by Costain.

# RESOLVED: Clerk to bring up all these issues with Costain prior to next Monday's meeting so that they can give a response.

- 2.2 The overhanging trees that are on the BT lines around Trerice urgently need cutting. This is the responsibility of the landowner and notice will be served by Cornwall Council if they do not take action.
- 2.3 It was commented that Farmers are not allowed to build a farm building within 400m of a dwelling. However, dwellings are being built within 400m of farm buildings. Could the Parish Council be mindful of this when looking at planning applications?
